



Mayor's Commission on Disabilities Minutes Monday, December 17, 2018

Chair Crass called the meeting to order at 12.05 PM.

1. Roll Call.

2. Approval of the Minutes of November 19, 2018 Meeting.

Motion by Leckel, seconded by Wilberg, to approve the November 19, 2018 meeting minutes. Motion passed.

3. Treasurer's Report.

Welcome back Katey! \$1036.04, no change.

Motion by Leckel, seconded by Nousaine, to accept the Treasurer's Report. Motion passed.

4. Lee Sandok Baker, Code Compliance Officer – snow removal.

Code Compliance Officer Baker introduced herself and said this is her second Winter on the job and dealing with snow removal on sidewalks. This year, after reviewing the policy and procedures for snow removal, a few changes have been made in the way the process will be enforced. Pedestrian safety is first and foremost when dealing with businesses or home owners to get them to clean the sidewalks after a snowfall.

Property owners are given 48 hours at the end of the snowfall to clear sidewalks and make them passable. After the 48 hours, if they were not cleared, a warning was given by sending them a card. The new policy still gives them 48 hours to clear, but no card will be sent. If they do not do snow removal after 48 hours, the City's contractor will go out and remove the snow, at the expense of the property owner.
