City of Superior announces expanded curbside absentee voting and absentee ballot drop boxes

The City of Superior announces beginning Monday, March 30, the City Clerk's Office will be closed to the public except for limited hours for curbside voting and in office absentee voting from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. To vote curbside (in front of the Government Center) please call ahead with your information and estimated time of arrival so your ballot is ready when you arrive. Once you arrive, follow the directional signs, park your car, and call the office at 715-395-7200 and the ballot will be brought to your car. Please have your Wisconsin Driver's License or ID ready to show us. The last day to vote in office or curbside is Friday, April 3rd.

If you have requested a ballot by mail already, please note at times the mail has been taking several days. If possible, we encourage you, a family member, or a friend or neighbor, to place your ballot in the drop boxes marked "absentee voting" in front of the Government Center rather than by return mail to ensure your ballot is received in time.

If possible, you are encouraged to vote absentee by mail, curbside, or in-office prior to election day for your safety and the safety of the election workers and the public. Staffing at each polling place will be at a bare minimum.
