The City of Superior is announcing the availability of the following budget document for a public review period of not less than five days:

**2019 CDBG Action Plan Amended:** The 2019 Action Plan amendment describes the activities the City intends to fund with Community Development Block Grant Coronavirus (CDBG-CV) funds. These activities are detailed in the table below.

The City of Superior has been awarded \$417,000 as part of a special allocation of Community Development Block Grant funds to be used to prevent, prepare for, and respond to the coronavirus (COVID-19). This allocation was authorized by the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act), Public Law 116-136, which was signed by President Trump on March 27, 2020. The CARES Act provides CDBG grantees with flexibilities that make it easier to use CDBG-CV grants and authorizes HUD to grant waivers and alternative requirements.

The City of Superior hereby requests public comment from citizens within the community, private for profit enterprises and non-profit organizations for assistance in determining the distribution of the 2020 CARES funding in accordance with the City’s Consolidated Plan. Following a public review of not less than five days, a public hearing will be held before the Common Council for the purpose of receiving comments on the proposed budget. The public hearing will be held as follows:

The public is encouraged to review this document and provide written comments directly to the City of Superior, Planning Department, and/or provide comments at the public hearing. Written comments should be received at or before the public hearing.
